

Behavioural and Emotional Disorder



Behavioural and Emotional Disorders effect many children and vary in their presentation and severity. Diagnostic Assessment will allow a Clinical Diagnosis to better understand the needs of your child.

Assessment Measures

- **Conner's Comprehensive Behaviour Rating Scale (CBRS)**
The Conner's CBRS is designed to provide a complete overview of child and adolescent concerns and disorders. It is a multi-informant assessment of children and youth (aged 6 to 18 years old) across multiple settings, with rating forms for parents, teachers, and youth. The Conner's CBRS is electronically administered to a child's parent and teacher to ascertain their observations about their behaviour. The parent read 203 items, and the teacher read 204 items, and decided how well each statement described the child, or how often the child displayed each behaviour in the past month. The parent/teacher responses to these statements were combined into several groups of items. Each group of items describes a certain type or area of behaviour.
- **Conner's Early Childhood (EC)**
The Conner's EC is an electronically delivered assessment, with rating forms for parents and teachers, that addresses child behaviour for ages 2 to 6 years. It aids in the early identification of behavioural, social and emotional problems. It also assists in measuring if the child is appropriately meeting major developmental milestones (Adaptive Skills, Communication, Motor Skills, Play and Pre-Academic/Cognitive).
- **Adaptive Behaviour Assessment System – 3rd Edition (ABAS III)**
The ABAS-III is a multidimensional and standardised assessment tool used to assess the functional skills necessary for daily living of individuals between 0 to 89 years of age. It offers a multi-informant assessment of children and youth across multiple settings, with rating forms for parents and teachers. This measure assesses 11 essential skill areas within 3 major adaptive domains: Conceptual, Social, and Practical, facilitating the identification of strengths and weaknesses. The ABAS-III is electronically administered.
- **Conner's 3**
The Conner's 3 is an electronically delivered assessment, with rating forms for parents and teachers, to obtain observations about the youth's behaviour. This instrument is designed to assess Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) and its most common co-morbid problems in children and adolescents (aged 6-18 years old).
- **Specific Tools**
A range of other specific assessment tools selected according to the individual needs of the client.
